### JAILHOUSE ROCK

- **Costumes will be required to be worn to class on Friday, May 3 for a details check.**
- **Since this is a details check so be sure to have everything done as explained below before coming to class that day.**
  - **Don't forget to wear your tan tights (NO PANTY HOSE) , and black tap shoes fastened with elastic instead of ribbons.**
  - **Don't forget to wear your chosen undergarment (if any) which should be skin tone in color, and totally hidden from view.**

PICTURE DAY: Saturday May 18. DRESS REHEARSAL and RECITAL: Saturday, June 8.

Important: Immediately try on your costume, and immediately double check to see if all pieces as listed below are included in your packet. Your costume package includes:

- Leotard with attached skirt
- Matching scarf
- Pink sequins
- Scrunchie- -set aside—we will not use
- Pop clip

### STRAPS

- Test to see that they stay on the shoulder during vigorous movement. Adjust accordingly.
- To make a wider strap, cover the existing strap with the Pink sequins.
- Securely sew the sequins to the costume in the following three places.
  - Top of the bodice in the front,
  - Top of the bodice in the back.
  - Top of the shoulder

### MATCHING SCARF

- Tie a knot in the center of the scarf.
- Securely sew the pop clip to the knot.
- Wear the knot close to the bun in the center-front, or center-top.
- If the scarf tends to fall forward into the face use extra clips to keep it back. Sew the clip under the scarf to keep in hidden from view.

### TAP SHOES

Buy black tap shoes- -no Velcro closures.

If you have ribbons, replace the ribbon with a loop of black elastic. Be sure the elastic is tight enough that the shoe cannot be kicked off, but loose enough to take the shoe on and off.

### STUDENTS WITH COSTUME CHANGES:

Smaller items such as headdresses and wristlets are easily lost backstage in our crowded conditions.

- A box with compartments that can fit on a chair is a good way to keep track of such items.
- **Required: Label each item with your name**, including headdresses, to help insure no mix-ups.
- Also, it is a good idea to practice costume changes including putting every item back in it's designated place.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Black tap shoes with black elastic replacing ribbons
<input type="checkbox"/>	Tan tights
<input type="checkbox"/>	Undergarment (if any) hidden totally from view
<input type="checkbox"/>	Shoulder straps tight enough
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pink sequins securely sewn in three spots
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pop clip securely sewn to knot of scarf
<input type="checkbox"/>	Scarf stays put during vigorous movement and out of face
<input type="checkbox"/>	Names in every article (even in headdress)
