SINGING IN THE RAIN- -Girls

- Costumes will be required to be worn to class on Friday, May 1 for a details check.
- Since this is a details check so be sure to have everything done as explained below before coming to class that day.
 - Don't forget to wear your tan tights (NO PANTY HOSE) , and black tap shoes fastened with elastic instead of ribbons.
 - Don't forget to wear your chosen undergarment (if any) which should be skin tone in color, and totally hidden from view.

PICTURE DAY: Saturday May 9. DRESS REHEARSAL and RECITAL: Saturday, May 23.

Important: Immediately try on your costume, and immediately double check to see if all pieces as listed below are included in your packet. Your costume package includes:

- Leotard with attached skirt
- Matching wristlets
- Hat
- Black stretch sequins
- Hat band
- Beige elastic and pop clips
- Choker- - -set aside as we will not use this

STRAPS

- To make a that covers the undergarment use the black stretch sequins as follows:
- Securely sew the sequins to the costume in the following two places.
 - Top of the bodice in the front, centered under the existing yellow strap
 - Top of the bodice in the back, **WITHOUT** criss-crossing, Line this strap up in such a way as to cover your chosen undergarment, if any. (See picture next page.)

SKIRT

Sew the split together in the back of the underskirt.

HAT

- Securely attach the headband to the hat so it cannot possibly come off.
- Securely sew the beige elastic to the hat for a chinstrap.
- Use the pop clips to secure the elastic to the hair.

TAP SHOES

Buy black tap shoes- -no Velcro closures.

If you have ribbons, replace the ribbon with a loop of black elastic. Be sure the elastic is tight enough that the shoe cannot be kicked off, but loose enough to take the shoe on and off.

If you have shoelaces, be sure to double-knot your bows.

STUDENTS WITH COSTUME CHANGES:

Smaller items such as headdresses and wristlets are easily lost backstage in our crowded conditions.

- A box with compartments that can fit on a chair is a good way to keep track of such items.
- **Required: Label each item with your name**, including headdresses, to help insure no mix-ups.
- Also, it is a good idea to practice costume changes including putting every item back in it's designated place.



Securely sew the black sequins to form a strap to hide undergarments. Do not criss-cross in back but instead come directly over the shoulder and straight down as shown in these pictures.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Black tap shoes with black elastic replacing ribbons
<input type="checkbox"/>	Tan tights
<input type="checkbox"/>	Undergarment (if any) hidden totally from view
<input type="checkbox"/>	Black shoulder straps securely sewed and properly placed
<input type="checkbox"/>	Split in back sewn together on underskirt
<input type="checkbox"/>	Wristlets tight enough
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hat band secured to hat
<input type="checkbox"/>	Beige elastic securely sewn to hat band
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pop clips to use on elastic to secure to hair
<input type="checkbox"/>	Names in every article (even in headdress and wristlets)
