DANCE ELECTRIC

- **Costumes will be required to be worn to class on Monday, April 27 for a details check.**
 - **Since this will be a details check so be sure to have everything done as explained below before coming to class that day.**
- **Don't forget to wear your tan footed tights (closest to your skin tone) and black jazz shoes.**
- **Undergarment, if any, should be totally hidden from view and skin tone in color.**

Important: double check to see if all pieces as listed below are included in your packet.

Your costume package includes:

- Bikertard
- Matching headband
- Top
- Pop clips

PICTURE DAY: Saturday May 9. DRESS REHEARSAL and RECITAL: Saturday, May 23.

BIKERTARD

- Try out the bidertard with vigorous movements, including bending and stretching. If the shoulder straps do not stay put, tighten accordingly.
- Then sew them at the adjustment sight so they can no longer be adjusted.
- Cut the white tag out.

TOP

- Cut the white tag out of the back of the neckline.
- Please shorten the bottom edge of the top as indicated below:
 - Leave as is: Sharone, Lotem, Amit
 - Shorten 1' both front and back: Leah
 - Shorten 2" in front and 1" in back: Lucy
 - Shorten 3" in front and 2" in back: Elah

HEADDRESS

- Wear the headband under the bun in the back, with the ears exposed on the sides, and some of the hair line showing in the front. The scrunchie portion will be twisted a little to the **STUDENTS** right.
- **Required: Securely sew the pop clips to the headdress. Be sure to note where to sew them with the scrunchie twisted to the side.**
- These clips work for most people, but be sure to check it out during vigorous dance movements. If it does work well, add another clip, or use another kind of clip which must be sewn to the head dress. Attach the clips in such a way that they run perpendicular to the direction the hair is being pulled into the bun.
 - Please note: Although bobby pins may be used in addition to the clips, it will not be acceptable to use them alone.

STUDENTS WITH COSTUME CHANGES:

- **Required: Label each item with your name**, as well, to help insure no mix-ups.
- Smaller items such as headbands are easily lost backstage in our crowded conditions. A box with compartments that can fit on a chair is a good way to keep track of such items.
- Also, it is a good idea to practice costume changes including putting every item back in it's designated place.

- **You can use the following to double-check if all items are completed.**

<input type="checkbox"/>	Tan footed tights
<input type="checkbox"/>	Undergarment (if any) hidden from view
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bikertard straps stay put
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bikertard straps securely sewn so they can't be adjusted
<input type="checkbox"/>	White tag cut out of both tops
<input type="checkbox"/>	Top at appropriate length
<input type="checkbox"/>	Required pop clips securely sewn to headdress
<input type="checkbox"/>	Headdress stays securely on
<input type="checkbox"/>	Name in every article (if in more than one dance, including headdress)
