

## MONDAY 6:30

### UNDER CONSTRUCTION

- Costumes will be required to be worn to class on **Monday, May 6.**
- This is a **details check so be sure to have everything done as explained below** before coming to class that day.
- Don't forget to wear your pale pink footed tights, pink ballet shoes secured properly with elastic, and chosen undergarment which should be skin tone color and totally hidden from view.

PICTURE DAY: Saturday May 18. DRESS REHEARSAL and RECITAL: Saturday, June 8.

Important: Immediately double check to see if all pieces as listed below are included in your packet.

Your costume package includes:

- Leotard and attached skirt
- Matching streamer
- White stretch sequins
- Pop clip

### SEQUIN STRAPS

- To make a wider strap, cover the existing straps with the white sequins.
- Securely sew the sequins in three locations on the straps: at the top edge of the leotard in the front and back, as well as at the top of the shoulder.

### VELCRO ATTACHMENTS

Using white 2" strips of Velcro, make attachments spots below the straps in the front and back, as shown. Be sure to put the rough piece on white just under the snaps, as shown, and the the soft piece on the inside of the black "pull down" piece.

Please note: Self-stick Velcro does not permanently attach to fabric and so it must be **securely** sewn in place.



### HEADDRESS

- Tie a knot in the middle of the matching streamer.
- Securely sew the pop clip to the knot. Wear the streamers hanging down from the top-right of the bun. Test out the headdress during vigorous movement. If this pop clip does not stay securely in place, replace it with another clip or barrette that works better for you. Please note: Although bobby pins may be used in addition to the clip, they may not solely be used.

### WHITE LABEL

Cut out the white label in the back.

### STUDENTS WITH COSTUME CHANGES:

- **Required: Label each item with your name**, as well, to help insure no mix-ups.
- Smaller items such as headdresses are easily lost backstage in our crowded conditions.
- A box with compartments that can fit on a chair is a good way to keep track of such items.
