DEJA VU

- **Costumes will be required to be worn to class on Tuesday, April 28 for a details check.**
 - **Since this will be a details check so be sure to have everything done as explained below before coming to class that day.**
- **Don't forget to wear your black footed tights or tall black crew socks and black jazz shoes. (Please note: Panty hose will not be acceptable as they are far too sheer. Target puts out what they call tights, but they are actually panty hose, so do not go to Target.)**
- **Undergarment, if any, should be totally hidden from view and skin tone in color.**

Important: double check to see if all pieces as listed below are included in your packet.

Your costume package includes:

- Camisole
- Jacket
- Pants
- **Headband- -set aside as we will not use**
- Pop clips
- Silver sequins

PICTURE DAY: Saturday May 9. DRESS REHEARSAL and RECITAL: Saturday, May 23.

CAMISOLE

- Try out the costume during vigorous movement. If the shoulders do not stay put, tighten appropriately.
 - Securely sew the strap to itself at the adjustment point so it can no longer be adjusted.

PANTS

- If pants are a little long, wear them scrunched up at the ankle.
- Check out the waistline of the pants during vigorous movement to see if the waistband is tight enough. If not, tighten accordingly.

HEADDRESS

- Using the stretch silver sequins form a loop to fit around the bun.

Required: Securely sew the two pop clips to the knot of the headdress. Sew them on in such a manner that they run perpendicular to direction that the hair is being pulled into the bun.

Please note: These clips work for most people, but be sure to check it out during vigorous dance movements. If it does work well, add another clip, or use another kind of clip which must be sewn to the headdress. Also: Although bobby pins may be used in addition to the clips, it will not be acceptable to use them alone.

STUDENTS WITH COSTUME CHANGES:

- **Required: Label each item with your name**, as well, to help insure no mix-ups.
- Smaller items such as headdresses are easily lost backstage in our crowded conditions. A box with compartments that can fit on a chair is a good way to keep track of such items. (
- Also, it is a good idea to practice costume changes including putting every item back in its designated place.

- **You can use the following to double-check if all items are completed.**

<input type="checkbox"/>	Black jazz shoes
<input type="checkbox"/>	Black tall crew socks or footed tights
<input type="checkbox"/>	Undergarment (if any) hidden from view
<input type="checkbox"/>	Camisole straps stay put
<input type="checkbox"/>	Camisole straps securely sewn to themselves
<input type="checkbox"/>	Waist of pants tight enough
<input type="checkbox"/>	Headdress correctly constructed
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pop clips securely sewn to headdress
<input type="checkbox"/>	Headdress stays securely on and stays out of face
<input type="checkbox"/>	Name in every article (if in more than one dance, including headdress)
